## Love Your Pet... SPAY & NEUTER

Every February, in honor of the national Spay Day campaign, Foothills Animal Shelter increases education and awareness around the importance of spaying and neutering your pets. Not only can spaying and neutering make pets healthier by decreasing the chance of certain cancers, but it also helps to reduce pet overpopulation and unwanted litters of puppies and kittens.

While we put greater emphasis in February, it's like Spay Day all year round for Foothills Animal Shelter! Last year, **4,323** pets were spayed and neutered by us. Not only do we spay/neuter our adoptable pets, but we also offer the surgery at a low-cost to the public year-round. **Dogs are \$75 for a spay and \$65 for a neuter. Cats are \$40 for either a spay or neuter. Appointments must be scheduled in advance.**

In honor of Spay Day, there will also be **two additional Saturday spay/neuter clinics in February:**
